# Status of PACA Activities

Activity	Status
Country-Led Situation Analysis and Action Planning	Conducted in 2014/15. Supplemental report already submitted.
AfricaAIMS	Phase 1&2 samples of maize and groundnuts collected & analysed for aflatoxins, results submitted to PACA continental.
National Aflatoxin Control Action Plan	Action plan developed, In May 2015 it was validated and approved for implementation
Mainstreaming	March 2016 the action plan was approved to be used as part of ASDP2
Business Meeting	Was held in May 2016, over 50 stakeholders participated
Implementation of Action Plan	Implementation has started in some of the activities- Action plan adopted in ASDP2

# Major Achievements To Date and Current Activities

- National steering committee for mycotoxin control established
- AfricaAIMS established and running
- Strategic action plan for mitigation of the aflatoxin problem developed and mainstreamed into TAFSIP
- PACA country office established and Country officer hired

# Priorities for 2017-2018 and Beyond

- Apply for GAFSP funds
- Develop National communication strategy for mycotoxin control
- Develop aflatoxin smart Good Agricultural Practices (GAP) and Good Animal Husbandry Practices (GAHP) guidelines for prevention of aflatoxin contamination
- Increase access to improved Post Harvest Handling and storage facilities (e.g. improved threshing, drying and storage technologies) for use at community level

# Priorities for 2017-2018 and Beyond

- Improve knowledge for processors, traders, stockists and produce dealers in quality control and assurance with respect to aflatoxin contamination
- Introduce accountability frameworks and use of M&E tools
- Reconstitute the National Mycotoxin Steering Committee to include donors, media and food security department
